- Ingredients for medicine and even ice-cream come from marine plants.








Did you know?

Our plan of action

2. Reduce, reuse, recycle plastic

Replace disposable water bottles with reusable ones.

School survey results: 42%= disposable bottles

58% = reusable bottles

Launch a school campaign to increase the use of reusable water bottles. Target 90%

- Whole school plastic bottle art activities
- Two minute street clean activities
