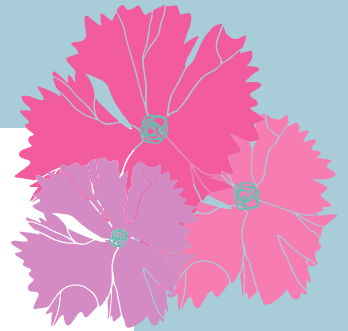
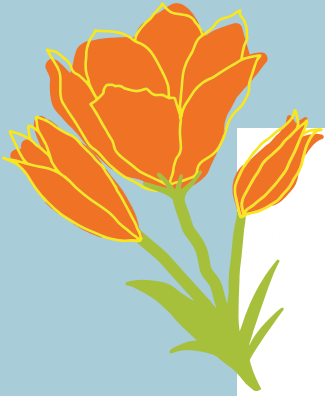

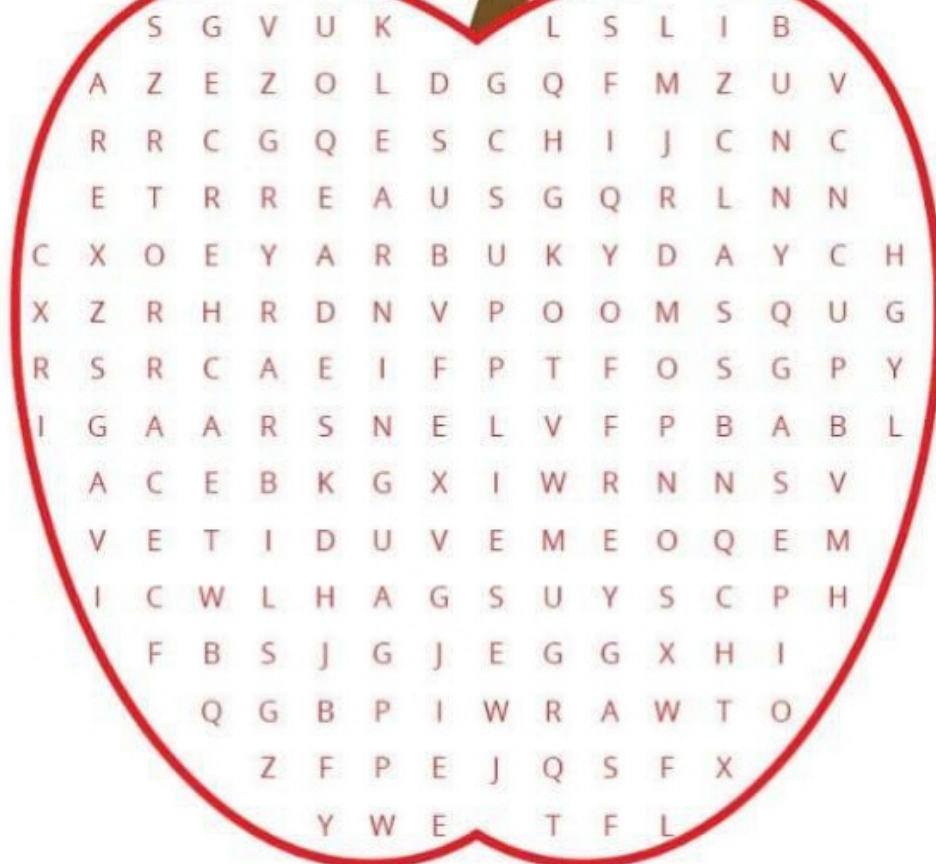

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Recipes

Very Berry Jelly

*Always ask a parent/guardian first.

Ingredients

- 135g pack of raspberry or blackcurrant flavour jelly
- 150g mixed frozen fruit


Tools

- Heatproof jug
- Spoon
- Jelly moulds

Place the jelly into a measuring jug and pour over 300ml of boiling water. Stir until the jelly has dissolved.

Stir the fruit into the jug. Top up with cold water to make 600ml if necessary.

Spoon the mixture between one large jelly mould or four individual moulds and place in the fridge for about 3 hours until set.



Top tip - using frozen berries prevents them from floating to the top.

Recipes

Toffee Popcorn

*Always ask a parent or guardian first

Ingredients

- 30ml corn oil
- 100g popping corn
- 60g butter
- 60g soft brown sugar
- 75ml golden syrup

Method

Heat the oil in a saucepan.

Add the corn, with the lid on, shake to coat in the oil. Over a medium heat, shake the pan occasionally until the corn has popped.

Remove from the heat. Place the butter, sugar and syrup in another pan. Stir together over a medium heat until the butter has melted and the sugar has dissolved.

Top tip!

Wait until there are 3 to 5 seconds between each "pop" before you turn off the heat!

Put the popcorn into a large mixing bowl. Drizzle the toffee over the top.

Stir until the popcorn is coated. Stop stirring when the sauce has cooled and is setting. Leave until cool enough to eat.

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Daffodils are among the first flowers to tell us it is spring! As part of our spring crafts, we can make egg carton daffodils – great as project to kick off spring & also perfect for Easter crafts using old egg cartons.

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*Always ask a parent or guardian before you start any arts or crafts.

You will need

- egg cartons
- white, yellow, orange paints & brush
- white, yellow papers, scissors, glue

First, tear the 'cup' parts off the egg carton.

Tear the edges roughly by hand so they look like natural ruffles.



Paint the torn egg cartons with yellow & orange colours to make the middle part of the flower.

Tip: With normal acrylic paints, yellow paints are translucent and white paints are opaque. So if you paint yellow colour directly onto a dark egg carton, it can look dull.

Paint them with white first, wait until it dries completely, then paint yellow colour on top. This way the yellow will look vivid and bright! 😊

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Daffodils have 6 petals, ask children to count the number of petals and help them draw a template.

Pinch the middle of each petal to make it more 3-dimensional as in the photo below.



Glue the painted egg cups in the middle.

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Oat & Raisin Cookies

Preheat oven to 180°C

Cream 100g soft butter or margarine and 100g soft brown sugar together



Add half teaspoon mixed spice, mix well



Sieve in half teaspoon bread soda



Add 50g of raisins or sultanas



Combine well together, if not dry add 1/2 spoons water



Lightly beat 1 egg and add to bowl, mix



Add 175g porridge



Add 100g wholemeal flour



You could replace mixed spice and raisins with vanilla extract and choc chips

Spoon or scoop mixture on to a tin lined with baking paper



Bake for 12-15 mins

Cool on wire tray

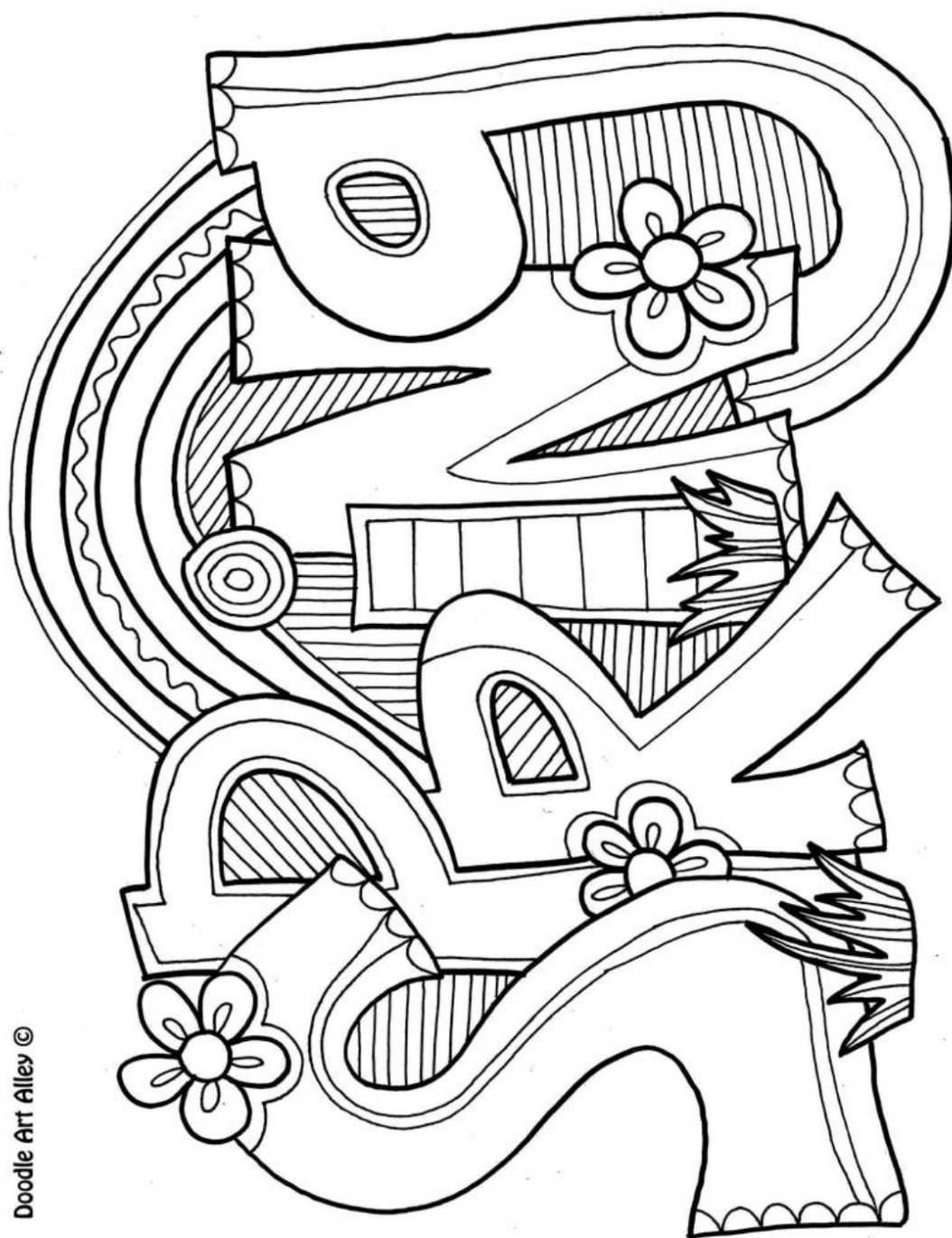
